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
PREVENTT News

A Note from the Chief Investigator

Dear PREVENTTers

Many thanks for all the hard work you have all been putting into PREVENTT. We are doing well and 2014 has been a success. The trial is on track and we have international recognition.

We currently have 26 sites open and another 5 in process. We are launching another advertising campaign through the CRN and also Association of Surgeons and have a target of 35 sites open to recruitment. This way we will aim to achieve 20 patients a month in 2015. I know it has been challenging to set up the trial and we have been in regular communication with all PIs and nurses. The issues and problems experienced are similar to other trials. We are really keen to help with recruitment and ensure that the trial is successful across all our sites.

With Christmas coming up it is an excellent opportunity to really set up recruitment ready for the start of 2015. The reason is that most surgery generally shuts down over Christmas and New Year.

Consequently there is now a push to get cases done by Christmas as most surgeons are planning their diaries till the year end. Second is that many surgeons are booking non urgent cases for January rather than operate over the two week holiday period. Therefore there are opportunities to recruit before Christmas and also plenty of time to plan for cases in January as the time between recruitment and operation will be extended.

We have been listening very closely to comments and the next round of protocol changes will hopefully be in place for the start of the new year. This includes a change in the HB for men from 12g/dL to 13g/dL and a change to the definition of major surgery (one hour).

Overall PREVENTT is all going well and this is really down to the effort from all of you, screening and recruiting into the trial. We really appreciate your time and enthusiasm and look forward to seeing you at the Investigator Meeting in January.
